WHY SHOULD YOU HAVE A NON-CARDIAC VASCULAR SCREENING?

Cardiovascular Disease is a leading cause of death or complications in men and women, which lead to disability.

Each year 700,000 American men and women suffer strokes and 200,000 of those are under the age of 45. Many could be prevented by proper diagnosis such as a **Carotid Artery Screening** **Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm** is silent but deadly, 3 out of 4 have no symptoms. When an aneurysm ruptures the likelihood of surviving is only 25%.

Peripheral Vascular Screening Between 25-30 million people over 70 have Peripheral Vascular Disease. If your leg muscle cramps after walking a short distance and you have leg pain, you may be suffering from Peripheral Vascular Disease. If this disease progresses, non-healing ulcers may develop and can lead to loss of limb.

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WARNING SYMPTOMS OF STROKE:

- One-sided weakness/numbness in the leg/arm/face
- Temporary blindness 1 eye
- Difficulty speaking (*inability to talk/slurred speech*)

WARNING SYMPTOMS OF AAA:

- Abdominal pain
- Abdominal tenderness
- GI symptoms nausea/weight loss
- Low back pain

WARNING SYMPTOMS OF PERIPHERAL VASCULAR DISEASE:

- Pain in the hip, thigh or calf area upon walking and relief when resting
- Foot pain at rest
- Non healing leg and foot ulcers
